#### The assignment of the studio 2021-2022

The 2021-22 edition of the 4<sup>th</sup> year Architect-Engineer « *climatic heterotopias* » Architectural Design Studio focuses on decarbonization, resilience and equity working on the subject of the Architecture at Zero international competition. The challenge is to design affordable housing for farmworker families in California's Central Valley. Key aspects of this project include responding to the challenges of equity and resilience through the design solution. To enhance the relevance, qualities and impact of architecture in climate change the architectural design aims to provide an innovative methodology based upon blending learning that focuses on developing climate-resilience for instituting contemporary built heritage across the globe being inspired from the European context. Bringing together the multiple disciplines of architecture and built environment, heritage studies, engineering, design, climate science, and software technologies and informatics the architectural design studio aims to innovate education and to develop a multi-disciplinary knowledge for building a culture of prevention and mitigation (culture of preparedness) to address climate change. For these reasons, even if the case study is geographically located in the USA, the architectural design studio is integrated into the e-CREHA european project in order to develop an ingenious projectual *modus operandi* regarding the conception of a contemporary architectural heritage to the development of climate-adaptive strategies for a resilient society.










